

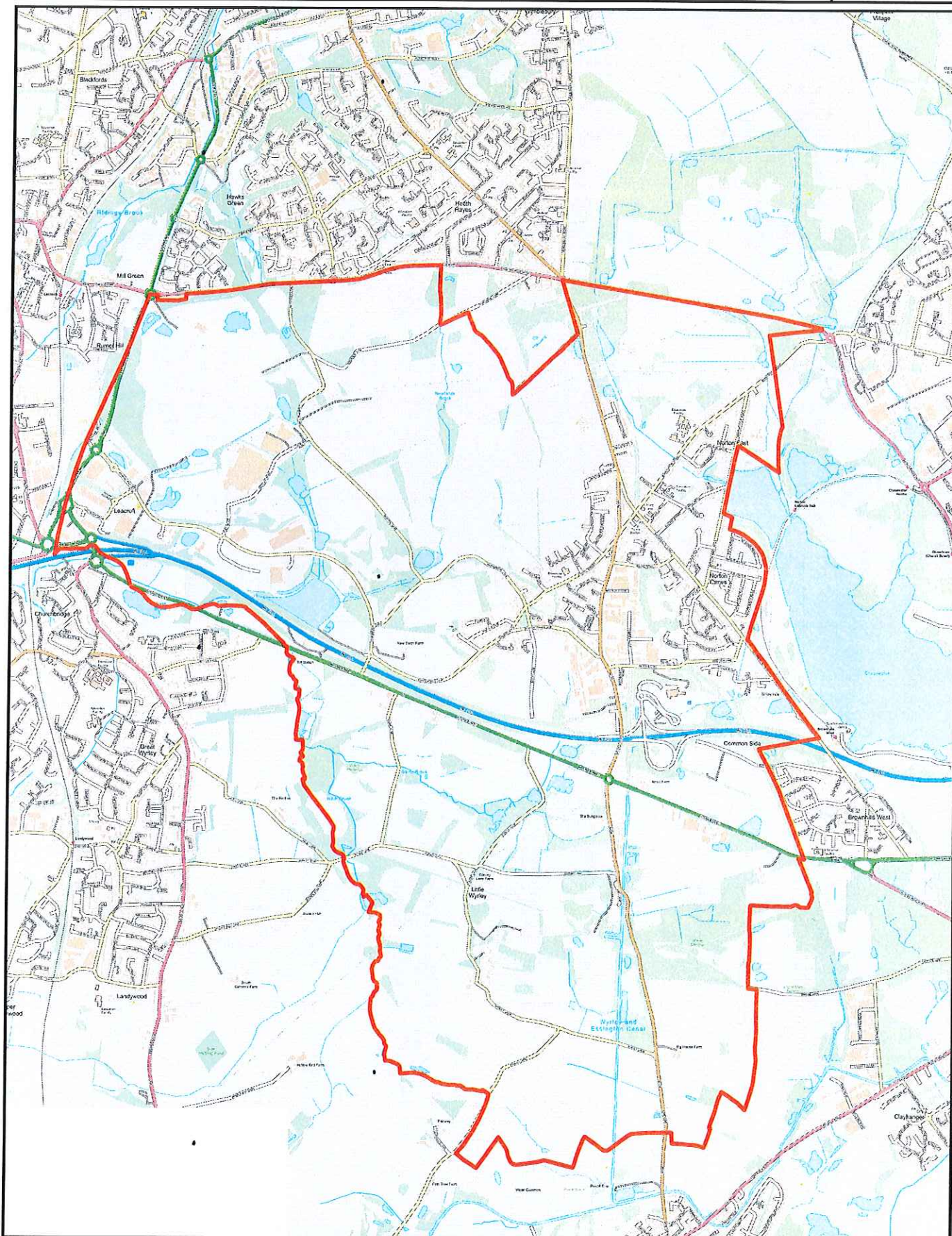


# Norton Canes Parish Boundary
