## **Cannock Town Centre Perception Survey Results**


The survey launched on 10 May and closed on 21 June 2022. 1219 responses were received, 13 were paper copies and 1206 were completed online. The town Centre drop-in sessions produced 41 responses. The overall total is 1260 responses.

The results are set out below:




















