I feel there are several reasons why this land is unsuitable for development due to volume of traffic, impact on wildlife, limited infrastructure and effect on national policy requirements reference greenbelt.

At present we see heavy congestion on Wimblebury Road, Cannock Road and around Five Ways island. This impacts not only around rush hours but also several times through the day. With the proposal of 400 additional houses at Wimblebury Road and 700 additional houses at Cannock Road, could mean approx. an additional 1,300 cars in an area of busy roads. Everyday there are bottlenecks at all the junctions entering Five Ways roundabout and queues of traffic toward the next roundabout at Chase Terrace, past Gold's and the Texaco garage on the road coming from Cannock, queueing traffic coming from Norton Canes can be back up to the entrance of Lodge Farm. Adding another 1,300 vehicles to the mix can only make the matter worse. We cannot see the how the proposed relief road from the Brickworks/Wimblebury Road to Cannock Road running behind the allotments and Heath Hayes Park, is an answer to the congestion at Five Ways. The junction at Cannock Road will only allow vehicles to turn left toward Chase Terrace, and have no impact on the congestion at Five Ways.

Both sites have a hive of fauna and flora and is regularly visited by deer. The greenbelt land and openness are vital to the wellness and mental health of residents who regularly walk or ride the area, and would be significant affected by this development. We understand that the National Policy requirement is for the landscape character to be protected and conserved, which again these developments are not in keeping with this policy.

Local infrastructure is already stretched where resources are not meeting the needs of residents, which we believe Cannock Chase District's population density is placed higher than other surrounding Districts such as Stafford and Lichfield. Local schools are already oversubscribed with high classroom sizes and will only suffer with more families planned to move to the area. There is not enough GP surgeries in the area for the current population. Average current waiting rate to see a GP can vary from 7 to 21 days, depending on location. Introducing another 1,000+ residents into the area would only compound the problem without further rebuild.


This proposal is grossly unsound on several levels as mentioned above. We feel it is unfair to burden our heavily populated district, which is more populated than neighbouring districts, with even more development which would degrade quality of life, impact on fauna and flora and free roaming deer. Finally, we believe the proposal does not follow or comply with the National Policy requirement outlined in the local plan of 2024.
