
Taxi Wheelchair Accessible Survey Results

45 responses were received in total and the results are set out below:


1) Do you use a wheelchair or care for somebody who does?


2) If you do use a wheelchair or care for somebody who does, do you require the use of a Taxi Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle?


3) How often do you or somebody you care for require the use of a Taxi Wheelchair Vehicle?


4) Do you struggle to book Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles?
