Before any site work is carried out the following items need to be addressed:

- A5190 would require major upgrading to allow for increased vehicle use.
- Five ways island is a major bottleneck, the increase in vehicle usage will only
 create major tailbacks creating big problems for residents living on that stretch of
 road. Should the Wimblebury road site development take place this island will become even more congested and probably lead to more accidents.
- Tip Island may have lights but with increased traffic will lead to long delays at rush hour with severe congestion in the town centre when the Orbital road floods and is closed.
- The access into and out of the new estate if built would be troublesome, building a new island close to the existing one would probably lead to road chaos as residents attempt to leave.
- The current infrastructures are totally inadequate in their present form, the Health Centre in Gorsemoor Road is over subscribed, trying to book an appointment with a doctor is a lottery that is totally unacceptable. A new health centre would be required to cater for any large scale influx of people.
 The primary schools in the area would find it difficult to absorb a large number of students, a new primary school would also be required. (This might have been alleviated had the promised school behind Tesco been built when the estate was)
- The current waste pumping station on the Lichfield road has seen a good deal of maintenance work taking place recently, the question is could it cope?
- Wildlife in the area has over recent years seen the wholesale destruction of its habitat, the number of deer that are in the area are having to stray further afield to find food and have been seen on estates all around Chasewater. This development would only create problems as this site is regularly visited by varying numbers of deer, large stags have been photographed grazing by a childrens park in Hawks Green.
- Statistics from Staffordshire.gov.uk show that the population density of Cannock Chase district is greater than the neighbouring districts of Stafford (x6) and Lichfield (x4). Shouldn't these other districts take their fair share of future housing. This development will only be the start of Heath Hayes losing its identity.
